Shapoor Ahmadi To Speak Sunday, October 1, in a Combined Sunday School Session and in Worship



Shapoor Ahmadi is the Founder of Operation Promises, and part of the leadership of the Liverpool Iranian Church. He is an Associate Evangelist with Mission24.

Shapoor, a Civil Engineer and former asylum seeker from Iran, is all too familiar with the fears and struggles that refugees experience after leaving their war-torn homelands or oppressive governments. Now based in Liverpool, he pastors the Liverpool Iranian Church and leads the Middle East Outreach Department of Mission 24.

Shapoor is familiar with the religious identity that keeps many immigrants in bondage, a bondage that appears to be weakening as more and more new arrivals in Europe are expressing interest in learning about Jesus, and the salvation, hope and life he offers.

As a former devout Muslim, Shapoor is uniquely qualified to reach immigrants, especially those who call Islam their faith. Fluent in Farsi, and coversant in Turkish, he can easily communicate and explain the foundations and Biblical truths of the Christian faith to his brothers and sisters from the Middle East, and other parts of Asia and Africa. In addition, his first-hand knowledge of Islam has equipped him with a special advantage when it comes to countering misunderstandings, objections or misconceptions that many Muslims have about Jesus in general.

Shapoor's ministry aims to reach more refugees in the city of Liverpool and further afield through visiting local hostels and befriending refugees, partnering with churches throughout Europe to reach refugee communities, holding training events and conferences for believers in the Near East and running a "House of Prayer" in Liverpool.

Based in Liverpool, England — the first stop for refugees entering England — Shapoor calls this strategic location home for him and his outreach.

Today, our world is witnessing a phenomenon like none before—more Muslims are coming to the saving knowledge of Jesus as their Lord and Savior than in any other time in history. Shapoor's ministry is part of this movement.

SESSION HIGHLIGHTS August 2023

- 1. Approved transferring Anna Jennings Nix's membership to the Madison Methodist Church in Madison, MS.
- 2. Committees Chairs were reminded their 2024 budgets need to be submitted at the September Session Meeting.
- 3. Items of Information from the Kindergarten: Current enrollment is 39 and will increase to 44 by Feb. 2024. Current teachers are Caroline Falls (1 year-old's), Debby Powers (older 1's and 2's), Sarah Kay Davidson (older 2's), Margie Barger (3's), Lorie Guenther (4's), Jamie Bartlett (Activity/Teacher/Assistant), Ryann Donahoe (1/2 Day Assistant). The staff participated in a 2-day education session with training in CPR, participation in a director's course and a review of warning signs of autism/ learning problems. Two Smart Boards were acquired. Procare, an online system allowing parents to check children in and out, pay tuition, communicate with teachers, etc., will be utilized. The annual fire inspection was passed.
- 4. Approved the "Chosen Bible Study" for Wednesday Youth Bible study, and "IronStream Media" for Youth Sunday School.
- 5. Approved offering the opportunity for an international mission trip with Ahava Ministries over the upcoming 2024 Spring Break.
- 6. Approved the Fall Youth Calendar.
- 7. Approved Toni Power and Susan Gregory as members of the Youth Committee, Class of 2026. These are second terms for each.
- 8. Approved a request from Dr. Rusty Douglas to borrow FPC's Church of Scotland tapestry for Montreat's Kirkin' Celebration on Memorial Day of 2024. Katharine Douglas Taylor will transport the tapestry to and from Montreat.
- 9. Approved the 2023-2024 dates of worship, other observances, and communion.
- 10. Approved a new system of scheduling communion servers.
- 11. Approved allocating \$3,000 from the General Memorial Fund for the return of the Classics at First Concert Series for this Fall and the Spring of 2024.
- 12. Approved inviting our missionary, Shapoor Ahmadi, to preach in worship on World Communion Sunday, October 1, 2023.
- 13. Approved a combined Sunday School class along with breakfast on October 1 to hear Shapoor Ahmadi speak about his work with Iranian refugees in Liverpool, England.
- 14. Approved Miller King to lead the fall adult SALT class, with Dallas Baker as back-up, in "Combating Cultural Christianity."

SESSION HIGHLIGHTS, continued

- 15. Approved the children's fall and winter SALT classes using "The Travel Guide to the Fruits of the Spirit" by Group Publishing.
- 16. Approved the women's Sunday School class using these books on marriage: Dr. Emerson Eggerich's "Love and Respect" and Gary Thomas' "Sacred Marriage".
- 17. Received a gift in the amount of \$5,000 from Jay and Becky Evans in honor of Gwen Evans and in memory of Jim Evans. Stewardship and Finance will decide at their September meeting how the money is to be used.
- 18. Approved the covered drop off and parking lot plans for the Kindergarten and Education Building as outlined by the Building and Grounds Committee, and to recommend such to the congregation.
- 19. Approved accepting the bid of KT Builder for construction of the covered drop off and parking lot in the amount of \$507,250.00
- 20. Approved notifying and educating the congregation about the proposed construction project.
- 21. Authorized the Stewardship and Finance Committee to take the steps necessary to acquire the funds for the cost of construction of the covered drop off and parking lot.
- 22. Called a Congregational Meeting on Sunday, September 17, 2023, for the purpose of 1) authorizing the covered drop off and parking lot project, and 2) authorizing a Capital Campaign to pay for the project.
- 23. Reported that Kristen Montgomery has resigned her position as church secretary to take a position with Delta Streets Academy.
- 24. Staff Conferences are scheduled for Sept. 18.
- 25. Witness Meetings with benevolence recipients are scheduled for Sundays, August 20, 27, and September 10.




Proposed Covered Drop-Off and Parking Lot for the East side of the Van Arnold Education Building

The Session has called a Congregational Meeting on Sunday, September 17, 2023, for the purpose of 1) authorizing the covered drop-off and parking lot project and, 2) authorizing a Capital Campaign to pay for the project.

This project provides safe, off-street loading and unloading for adults and children entering the building for Sunday School or Kindergarten. It also provides for fifteen additional parking spaces, two of which will be designated as handicap parking.
